★From Narita Airport to Tokyo Station

1	Narita Express (N'EX)	60 minutes	3,140 yen	No transfer	The most comfortable and convenient option. All seats are reserved.
2	Keisei Skyliner + JR Yamanote Line	60 minutes	2,780 yen	One transfer	Transfer to the JR Yamanote Line at Nippori Station.
3	JR Narita Line Rapid	90 minutes	1,410 yen	No transfer	No reservation required, inexpensive, and no transfers needed. May be crowded during peak hours.
4	Low-Cost Highway Bus (TYO-NRT)	60 minutes or more	1,500 yen	No transfer	No reservations (first-come, first-served). Arrives at the Nihonbashi Exit of Tokyo Station.
5	Airport Limousine Bus	60 minutes or more	3,100 yen	No transfer	Reservation required. Arrives at Tokyo City Air Terminal (T-CAT).
6	Taxi	60 minutes or more	25,000 yen	No transfer	Private space. Convenient for late night or early morning travel.
